

Contract for the transfer of copyright on a contribution to the journal *cArgo*, on an exclusive basis.

the journal *cArgo*, 45 rue des Saints-Pères 75006 Paris, represented by its editors, Mr. Erwan Dianteill and Mr. Francis Affergan, by delegation of signature of its director of publication, Mrs. Clerici, president of the University of Paris.

hereinafter referred to as the "Journal", on the other hand.

Preamble

The Journal publishes a periodical entitled *cArgo, revue d'Anthropologie Culturelle & Sociale*, under the numbers ISSN 2274-1011 (Print) and ISSN 2265-6405 (Online), hereinafter referred to as the "Periodical", which it publishes as well as disseminates in digital format in free, full and immediate access under the Creative Commons Attribution - Noncommercial - No Derivative Works 4.0 International License, on its Web site: <https://www.cargo.canthel.fr/>

The author has submitted an article entitled (hereinafter referred to as the "Contribution") to the Journal for publication in the issue of the Periodical.

At the time of submission to the Journal, the Author has warranted that he/she has not proposed this Contribution for publication in another publication or had this Contribution proposed for publication in another publication discontinued.

This Contribution was written with First Name Last Name, co-author(s).

Definitions

The "final version of the manuscript accepted for publication" is the one whose content has been scientifically validated and editorialized (standardized, harmonized and structured).

The "Editor's PDF" is the final version of the manuscript accepted for publication after formatting by the Editor.

Art. 1 - Purpose of the contract

The Author transfers exclusively to the Journal the rights to exploit his or her Contribution in printed and digital form.

Art. 2 – Obligations of the Author

The Author undertakes to submit to the Journal, no later than, his/her final and complete Contribution, carefully proofread and edited in accordance with the Editorial Recommendations provided to the Author and available online on the Journal's website. The Author shall provide his/her Contribution in the form of text files (.doc, .docx, .odt formats) together with any image files (.jpeg, .png, .tiff formats in 300 dpi).

The Author guarantees that this Contribution is original and not already published by another publisher. In the event that his/her Contribution contains excerpts of text or illustrations borrowed from other works, the Author will provide the Journal with all necessary reproduction permissions for publication purposes.

The Author also guarantees that his Contribution does not contain anything that falls under the laws and of a nature to engage the responsibility of the Journal, and guarantees to the Journal the full enjoyment of the rights transferred against all disorders, claims and evictions whatsoever.

Art. 3 – Transfer of print and digital exploitation rights

The Author assigns to the Journal the right to reproduce, represent and adapt his or her Contribution in **printed form** and, in particular:

- the right to reproduce the Contribution, in the Periodical or separately, in printed form, on all current or future analog and electronic, opto-numeric or magnetic media, such as CDs and USB keys, by press, including pre-- and post-publication, by micro-reproduction and by photocopying not intended for sale ;
- the right to represent the Contribution in the Periodical or separately, by all current or future processes of communication to the public, in particular by dissemination in libraries and educational and research institutions, as well as in dissemination via the Internet by communication to the public online.

The Author also grants the Journal the right to use the Contribution in **digital form**, and in particular :

- to reproduce his/her Contribution in the Periodical or separately, in the form of electronic files in all existing or future formats such as HTML, XML, PDF, ePub, on all current or future digital recording media such as Internet servers, USB keys, hard disks, memory cards, tablets, computers, e-readers, cell phones, electronic paper or e- paper, enabling digital data to be stored temporarily or permanently ;

- to represent his or her Contribution in the Periodical or separately, to enable it to be communicated to the public, free of charge, by all current or future processes, in particular via the Internet and the networks of all legal entities under public or private law, such as companies, libraries, educational and research establishments, with a view to consulting the Contribution online and downloading it via a remote or local computer connection;

- to adapt the Contribution in the form of a multimedia work or to integrate it into a multimedia work, to reproduce it on any medium and to represent it by any of the processes indicated above.

The Author also authorizes the Journal to disseminate his Contribution in free access under the **Creative Commons Attribution-NonCommercial-NoModification 4.0 International License**, for all the modes and media of exploitation mentioned above, which means that any interested person will have the right to re-exploit all or part of his Contribution without having to ask for his agreement, under the following conditions

- obligation to name the Author (BY) ;
- prohibition (NC) to make a commercial use of it;
- prohibition (ND) to modify it;

Given the mission of dissemination of knowledge and research results in which the publication of the Contribution is included (Education Code, article L. 123.6), and in accordance with article L. 122-7 of the Intellectual Property Code, the Author expressly agrees to transfer these rights to the Journal free of charge.

These rights are transferred to the Journal in all countries, for the duration of the literary and artistic property according to French and foreign laws and international conventions, including any extensions that may be made to this duration and by all current or future processes.

The Journal may exercise these rights itself or by transferring them to third parties; in this case, it undertakes to inform the Author.

Art. 4 – Obligations of the Journal

The Journal undertakes to publish the Contribution in the issue of the Periodical, within 8 months, except in cases of force majeure (pandemic, etc.), from the time the Author submits the version of the Contribution accepted for publication by the Editorial Board.

Prior to this, the Journal ensures that the Contribution meets the requirements of an academic publication and provides it with editorial added value (spelling and typographical checks, control of the bibliography and compliance with standards, structuring, control and treatment of the iconography).

The Journal undertakes to provide the Author, upon publication, with an electronic reprint in PDF format. As the Journal uses the Contribution in both a printed and a digital version, the press release obtained from the Author is valid for both versions, as long as they do not differ (beyond some possible additions specific to the digital version such as hypertext links).

Art. 5 – Open archive policy

The Journal authorizes the author to deposit the PDF version of his or her work in an open archive (a platform that is perennial and can be consulted by all without prior registration), under the CC-BY-NC-ND license, as soon as his or her contribution is published in the *cArgo* Journal.

Academic social networks (such as ResearchGate or Academia.edu) are not open archives: the deposit must be made in an open archive, in particular for reasons of durability, with a possible link to this open archive from the academic social networks.

Art. 6 – Applicable law and settlement of disputes

The present contract is subject to French law. Any dispute that may arise in connection with this contract shall be submitted to conciliation prior to any recourse to the courts.
